To: Whom it may concern

I am writing this in regards to some stained glass art work that Ms Susan Peters did for our church this past year.

When we ordered a new roof for our church in November 2005, it was discovered that we had severe structural damage and needed to completely renovate the church building from top to bottom. The complete renovation from start to finish took eighteen months. For a while we were beginning to think that the contractor was never going to finish the job. However, finish he did and we have a beautiful new church.

When the new altar was installed, it was quite plain. Previously we had an altar with a stained glass front that she had made some years ago. I asked Ms Peters if she would make three stained glass panels for the new altar, the one on the left for Alpha, the Church Emblem in the middle and Omega on the right. She came down to Charleston from Charlotte, took some measurements, gave me a bid which I readily accepted and she agreed to do the job if I would give her sufficient time.


She received the commission to do the work in late 2006 with no time limit or delivery date stated. We agreed that when it was finished, she would come down and supervise the installation of the three panels.

She finished the job and delivered the three panels at the end of January 2007. They were installed by our Pastor, a Master Cabinet Maker and they fit to a "T".

When the panels were installed, I presented Ms Peters with the final payment and thanked her for a job well done.

We have received many favorable comments on our beautiful altar and we highly commend and recommend her work to anyone who is a lover of fine art stained glass.
